Pennsylvania Law Says...

Less-restrictive alternatives to guardianship must be considered before the court appoints a guardian.

Less-restrictive alternatives include:

- ▶ Financial and healthcare powers of attorney
- ▶ Representative payees for Social Security
- ▶ Health care representative of your choice
- ▶ Supported decision-making arrangements
